### **2007.06.20: Getting reacquainted with large format film**

I doubt that the date in this entry's title is correct but it's my guess as to when these photos were taken. It would be years before the film would see a lab, strangely, I couldn't have been more pleased what the heat and radiation damage has added to these photos. It was unexpected. Had I predicted that there would be so much loss in sensitivity I would have requested that the film be push processed two stops. Fuji NPS 160 metered at ISO 100 and shot on Gordon Henderson's Linhof Technika V (I think) 4x5 and I believe a Voigtlander APO-Lanthar 210/4.5 with some tilt and swing movement. Leanna, as usual, is my test subject for new film and cameras. It brought a smile to my face to see these photos again having totally forgotten about them.

Shot in the road next to my apartment which, coincidentally, is just across the alley from my studio.

A slightly tighter crop. Some vertical displacement used to prevent perspective distortion and some tilt movement used.
